Competitors not telephoning will be deemed to have withdrawn.

In the event of bad weather prior to the show, please telephone 01355 260 497 between 7pm and 10pm on Friday 17th to check that the show is going ahead.

TROPHIES

The Claymore Perpetual Shield will be awarded for the highest winning percentage mark from classes 5 - 8 on Sunday 19th.

A small trophy or prize will be presented to the winner of each class.

ROSETTES

Rosettes will be awarded from 1st - 6th in each class.

There will be a special rosette awarded to the highest placed junior competitor in each class.

QUALIFIERS

Classes 1 - 8 will be qualifiers for the Festival Association. All competitors achieving 60% or higher will qualify for the championships to be held at SNEC, West Lothian on 8 - 12th October 2009.

Classes 3, 4, 5, 7 & 8 (elementary only) will qualify for the Scottish & Northern Equestrian finals at SNEC, West Lothian - 25th October 2009.

SCOTTISH & NORTHERN EQUESTRIAN RIDING CLUBS IN SCOTLAND DRESSAGE CHAMPIONSHIPS - RULES FOR 2009

- Qualifiers for the Scottish & Northern Equestrian Riding Clubs in Scotland Dressage Championships will be run from 1st March to 31st August. Championships will be held at the Scottish National Equestrian Centre, West Lothian on Sunday 19th October.
- The Competition will be run under British Dressage rules as per normal Riding Club Dressage competitions
- Qualifiers will be run at Preliminary, Novice and Elementary levels.
- 1st & 2nd in each qualifying class will qualify. To qualify at Prelim & Novice a minimum percentage of 65% and 63% for Elementary must be obtained. Qualification does not pass down the line.
- The qualifying letter will be issued on the day of competition.
- The championship is only open to the horse/rider combination that qualified.
- There will be no commanders or whips at the championships
- Entries will be drawn for starting times
- At the Championships official prize giving's will take place and times of each prize giving will be posted on the notice board
- There will also be an Affiliated Championship run through British Dressage. The Scottish & Northern Equestrian Riding Clubs in Scotland Dressage Championship is not open to affiliated BD riders and BD registered horse.

Please note BD members may compete in these classes although they cannot qualify for the championships

RULES - PLEASE READ THE FOLLOWING NOTES CAREFULLY

Hats conforming to safety standard EN1384, PAS015 or prefixed with ASTM or SEI must be worn and secured at all times by anyone mounted on the showfield (no Beaglers).

Juniors are aged up to and including 16 years and seniors are 17 years and over on the day of the show.

Closing date for entries is Friday 11th July. Late entries will not be accepted. Entries must be paid in advance.

Cheques to be made payable to "Polnoon Castle Riders Association" and sent to: The Show Secretary, 65 Oak Avenue, East Kilbride G75 9ED.

If any class has an insufficient number of entries, it may be cancelled. Competitors will be given advance notice of cancellation of the class and entry fees will be returned. Entries may be limited.

Dogs must be kept on a lead **AT ALL TIMES**.

All horses and ponies **MUST** be 4 years old and over.

Neither the organisers nor anyone acting on their behalf accept any responsibility for loss or damage to persons, animals or property whatsoever.

The organisers reserve the right to refuse any entry without having to state a reason.

Complaints must be put in writing and given to the secretary accompanied by a £20 deposit, which will be returned if the organising committee upholds the complaint.

Registered horses/ponies must compete at their current level.

All junior competitors must be accompanied by a responsible adult.

DIRECTIONS

Greenfields of Avondale is located on the A71 near Drumclog, approximately half way between Strathaven & Darvel.

Approaching from Darvel, the Showfield is on your right, approx ½ mile on leaving Drumclog.

Approaching from Strathaven, the Showfield is on your left approx ¾ mile after 1st Gilmourton turn off, the entrance is almost hidden from this direction as it sits just after a right hand bend in the road so approach slowly!
