Entries

- Entry Fees: Classes 1,2,3 and 4 – £32.00/£30.00 KKRC members. Class 5 – £10.00
- All entries to be made online through www.kilmacolmridingclub.org.uk
- Entries will close at 1800hrs on Monday 23 July
- No refund of entry money will be made after the closing date.
- In the event of the competition being cancelled 10% of the entry money will be retained.

- The course will be open for walking on Friday 27 July from 1400hrs.

Rules and conditions of entry

- The competition will be run under BRC Rules
- All competitors must be members of BE/BRC/PC/BHS (GOLD) or provide evidence of their own third party insurance.
- All competitors must be 12yrs or over.
- All horses/ponies must be 5yrs old or over.
- Horses/ponies may compete only once
- All classes will be judged to an optimum time. **Stopwatches are NOT permitted.**
- Any falls of rider and or horse on course will incur elimination.
- Any competitor/rider falling in the warm up areas must be seen by the Doctor before being allowed to start. All fallers must report to the Doctor before leaving the event.
- Three refusals at any one fence or four accumulated refusals on course will incur elimination.
- By entering all competitors accept Kilmacolm and Kilallan Riding Club do not accept any responsibility for any accident, loss, damage, injury or illness to any horses, riders, spectators, vehicles or their contents or any other person or property whilst on the above site. All persons are responsible for their own actions.
- All riders – whether competing or not – must wear a riding hat while mounted that complies with the current BE/BRC/PC standards, and it must be correctly fastened at all times. Back protectors labelled BETA Level 3 2009 (or later) must be worn. Hat cameras are not permitted. Hat and Body Protector standards are listed on www.brcarea1.co.uk in the reference section.

- A BRC Steward will be on site to tag hats .
- Any special requests MUST be made on the entry form.
- Any complaint must be made in writing and handed to the secretary accompanied by a £20.00 deposit, within 30mins of the class ending. The deposit will be refunded if the complaint is upheld or at the discretion of the Chief Steward whose decision is final.
- A vet will be in attendance on the day. There will be no farrier.
